



BOIL WATER ADVISORY FOR THE VILLAGE OF HAY LAKES

On September 8, 2024, at 8:30 a.m. the Water Commission's line broke within the Village pumphouse. This resulted in a flood in the pumphouse, and we are unsure of quality of the Village's water at this time. Our Public Work's manager responded very shortly after 8:30 a.m. and worked with the Water Commission to assess the situation and take samples, which will be sent for testing on a rush order. We should receive test results back in 24hours.

While we are unable to guarantee the quality of water in the Village, we are advising all residents to boil their water for at least 3 minutes before consumption.

Thank you for your co-operation and patience while we work to get this situation taken care of as quickly as possible. We will keep everyone up to date on the situation and will advise when the Boil Water Advisory can be lifted.
